

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY OF MIT-ADT UNIVERSITY - 2022

To support the education of deserving students and encourage them to pursue professional & Technical courses in the university, the Management of MIT-ADT University provides various scholarships or tuition fee waivers to meritorious/deserving students. For this purpose, a comprehensive Scholarship Policy of the university has been prepared wherein various scholarships offered by schools of MIT-ADT University, State Government & Central Government have been mentioned.

The policy encompasses the awarding of scholarships based on both merit and the government's reservation policy applied to enrolled students. Each academic year the university aims to Grant a scholarship to a deserving student in each discipline. The university recognizes the possibility of providing other forms of financial support, subject to the availability of funds and compliance with government guidelines.

The following schools of MIT-ADT University offer scholarships to the students.

A. Free ship /Scholarships to students seeking admission in the A.Y. 2022-23 for B. Tech-Engineering programs based on their JEE / CET & PERA Percentile as per the following criteria.

The above scholarship applies on a first come first basis to 30% of total admissions seats. The continuation of the scholarship for next year can be availed only with a satisfying credit score of 8.0 CGPA of the current year.

D. Institute of Design:

The MIT Institute of Design grants full or partial scholarships to 5% of the total students each year.

Scholarship Committee

All scholarship applications received shall be scrutinized based on merit criteria defined by the scholarship selection committee. The scholarship selection committee matrix includes the Dean, Director, Head of Discipline, Associate Dean of Student Affairs, and Student Coordinator.

Eligibility Criterion

- The institute invites scholarship applications from students whose parents' income is below 8 lakhs per annum.

- The eligibility of the scholarships would depend upon the performance of the student and his/her financial needs.
- Students should not have any backlog in the current or previous academic year.

Selection Criterion

An equitable distribution of scholarships is ensured by the committee based on financial conditions, merit/s, and promotion of a program, not compromising on the competitive merit and qualifications of the eligible candidate.

Selection criteria include:

- academic merit which includes Grade Point Average (GPA),
- equity criteria (financial hardship, sole parent/carers, medical condition/disability, Indigenous, etc),
- location (regional, rural, or remote),
- personal attributes
- performance at interview.

Selection Procedure

- Scholarship applications are invited in the month of October-November.
- Applications are invited along with Parents' last 3 years IT returns/form 16 / Income certificate.
- Scrutiny of applications is done by the Student Coordinator and presented to the selection committee.
- A personal interview of each student is organized with the scholarship selection committee.
- On the basis of personal interviews Final list of Scholarship Awardees is prepared and announced.

Scholarship Amount

A few scholarships to be awarded during each academic year varies. The scholarship is awarded depending on the sanctioned budget; hence, the award amount of the scholarship may vary. The maximum amount is up to 50% of Tuition Fees.

Award notification.

The Student Coordinator shall communicate with the selected candidates. The scholarship award mentions the amount, type of scholarship, and duration of the scholarship. The award clearly explains to the awardee the necessary rules and regulations of the award.

Scholarship progression and character

The student has to maintain discipline and acceptable behavior as per the student manual during the scholarship period. A scholarship awardee student under any disciplinary action and/or pending disciplinary action shall result in termination and/or withdrawal of the award. Students maintain satisfactory performance in studies with no backlog. Students also act as ambassadors of the university.

E. Preeminent Education and Research Association (PERA) Scholarship

The members of Private Universities of Maharashtra State have formed an association named "Preeminent Education and Research Association" (PERA), Pune, registered under section 8 of the Company Act 2013 in the year 2017. As of date, PERA has more than 25 Private Universities including MIT-ADT University as esteemed members of this prestigious professional association.

The following four categories of scholarships are being offered by PERA for its Member students.

- 1) Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam PERA INDIGENT National Scholarship
- 2) Dr. Raghunath Mashelkar PERA GENIUS National Scholarship
- 3) Dr. Vijay Bhatkar PERA ASPIRE National Scholarship
- 4) PERA IGNITE Sports National Scholarship,

Eligibility criteria, selection procedure, and documents required as approved by the Association are as follows:

Eligibility Criteria:

Students admitted for the first year or second year after completing the diploma course, to the concerned program in any of the PERA member universities are eligible to apply for the scholarships. Applicants must fulfill the following eligibility criteria to get the PERA scholarships. A Candidate can apply for only one of the PERA scholarships.

The annual income of the family of the candidate should not be more than 8 lacs.</p>

F. Fee Concession Policy for the wards/spouse of employees of MIT Group of Institutions:

Fee concessions are being provided to the wards/spouses of employees of MIT Group of Institutions, based on their years of service, tuition fee of the particular program, and salary of the employees. For new/first-year students, the student must obtain a minimum of 60% marks in the qualifying/entrance examination. For the second year onward student fee concession will be continued for the next year provided the student acquires a minimum 6.5 CGPA in the previous year.

Terms and Conditions of the Fee Concession Policy:

- i) Employees must be in continued service of MIT Group of Institutions at least for one year before the year of application for fee concession.
- ii) If the employee leaves the organization (removed/retrenched/resigned/discontinued), he/she must pay the complete program fee of his/her ward/spouse for that academic year and after that if any.
- iii) Students may apply for concession in fee or scholarship schemes offered by individual schools. However, students will not get the benefit of multiple schemes. Even if the student is eligible for any other scholarship and applied for fee concession, the highest amount of one scheme will be considered while calculating the fee.

G. National Scholarships:

1) Post Matric Scholarship (PMS) for ST students:

The scheme covers professional, technical as well as non-professional and non-technical courses at various levels including correspondence courses covering distance and continuing education.

- i) A Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented by the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations.
- ii) 100% Central assistance over and above the committed liability of the state governments/UTs Administration from the Government of India.
- iii) The Scheme provides financial assistance to the Scheduled Tribe students studying at the matriculation or post-secondary stage.

iv) Scholarships are available for studies in India only.

v) The State Government and UT to which the applicant belongs award the scholarship.

vi) The scheme also covers central assistance to States/UTs for setting up Book Banks.

Eligibility:

- 1) Scholarships are paid to students whose parents/guardians' income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2.50 lakh per annum.
- 2) All children of the same parents/guardian are eligible.
- 3) Scheduled Tribe candidates who have passed the matriculation or higher secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education are eligible.
- 4) The scholarships are available for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses in recognized institutions except certain identified training courses like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Courses, Private Pilot License courses etc.
- 5) Students studying through correspondence courses are eligible.
- 6) Employed students on leave without pay for the entire duration of a full-time course are eligible for the course.
- 7) The scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend.
- 8) Students who have received coaching in any of the pre-examination training centers with financial assistance from the Government will not be eligible.

2. **Scheme of 'merit cum means based scholarship' for students belonging to minority communities:**

ELIGIBILITY: Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.

EARMARKING: i) A 30% scholarship is earmarked for female students of each minority community in a State/UT which is transferable to male students of that community in case of non-availability of female students in that community in the concerned State/UT. 30% is the floor and not the ceiling for eligible girl students.

ii) If the physical target of scholarship for a particular minority community in a state/UT is not utilized, it will be distributed among the same minority community in other States/UTs strictly in accordance with merit and without disturbing the national ratio. Any unutilized community quota shall be distributed amongst other communities again in accordance with merit and without affecting the overall national quota.

iii) A student residing in a particular State/UT will be entitled to a scholarship under the quota of that State/UT only irrespective of his/her place of study.

DURATION: A scholarship will be provided for the entire academic year/course. Similarly, the maintenance allowance will be given as a fixed lump sum amount for an academic year (Rs. 10,000/- for Hosteller and Rs. 5,000/- for Day Scholar).

3. Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan (PM-USP) Yojana:

The scholarships are awarded by the Ministry of Education, Government of India based on results of the Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. A maximum of 82,000 fresh scholarships per annum are provided for pursuing graduate /postgraduate degrees in colleges and universities and for professional courses, such as Medical, Engineering, etc.

ELIGIBILITY:

- i)** Students who are above the 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent.
- ii)** Pursuing regular degree courses and not correspondence or distance mode or pursuing Diploma courses
- iii)** Pursuing courses at colleges/institutions recognized by the All India Council for Technical Education and respective Regulatory Bodies concerned.
- iii)** Not availing the benefit of any other scholarship schemes including State-run scholarship schemes/ fee waiver & reimbursement schemes.
- iv)** Students with gross parental/family income up to Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible for scholarships under the scheme. An income certificate will be required only for fresh applicants

4. Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) for the wards of central armed police forces & Assam rifles and states/UTS police personnel, Ministry of Home Affairs:

Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) under the aegis of the National Defense Fund, was introduced in the academic year 2006-07 to encourage higher technical & professional education for the dependent wards & widows of Central Armed Police Forces & Assam Rifles (CAPFs & AR) Personnel.

From the academic session 2019-20, this scheme has further been extended for the dependent wards of States/UTs Police Personnel who are martyred during Terror/Naxal attacks.

ELIGIBILITY:

A) For CAPFs & Assam Rifles personnel: -

- I) Wards/widows of deceased CAPFs & AR personnel who died in harness/election duty, wards of personnel disabled due to causes attributable to the Government service, and Wards of Ex-CAPFs & AR personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards.

- II)** Wards/widows of retired and serving CAPFs & AR Personnel. (Personnel below Officer Rank) Pursuing first professional degree program in the field of Engineering, Medicine, Dental, Veterinary, BBA, BCA, B. Pharma, B.SC (Nursing, Agriculture, etc.), MBA and MCA, etc. in accordance with the guidelines as mentioned in Para- 8 (B).
- III)** Having a minimum 60% marks in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent in case of a new applicant.

Or

For applicants applying under renewal category, it is mandatory to pass each subsequent academic year of the professional courses being pursued by them with a minimum of 50% marks.

- IV)** A grace period of one year only for cases where there is a delay on the part of the candidate for submission of application for renewal of scholarship may be entertained.

B) For States/UTs Police personnel: Dependent wards of States/UTs Police Personnel who are martyred during Terror/ Naxal attacks are eligible under this category subject to the following: -

- I)** Pursuing first professional degree program in the field of Engineering, Medicine, Dental, Veterinary, BBA, BCA, B. Pharma, B.SC (Nursing, Agriculture, etc.), MBA and MCA, etc. following the guidelines as mentioned in Para- 8 (B).
- II)** Having a minimum 60% mark in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent in case of a new applicant.

Or

For applicants applying under renewal category, it is mandatory to pass each subsequent academic year of the professional courses being pursued by them with a minimum of 50% marks.

- III)** A grace period of one year only for cases, where there is a delay on the part of the candidate for submission of application for renewal of scholarship

DURATION: Up to five years (depending upon the duration of the course being pursued by the applicant and as approved by the respective regulatory body).

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: **I.** Rs. 3000/-per month for girls. To be paid annually after selection. **II.** Rs. 2500/- per month for boys @ Rs 36,000/-to each girl & Rs 30,000/- to each boy

5. Scheme of scholarships for students with disabilities

ELIGIBILITY:

- i) The scholarships are open only to Indian nationals.
- ii) All the components of scholarships are open to students with benchmark disability i.e. 40% or more disability as defined in ‘The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, and having a valid certificate of disability issued by the competent authority as prescribed under Rules.
- iii) Not more than two children with disabilities from the same parents will be entitled to receive the benefits of the scheme. In case the second child is a twin, the scholarship under the schemes will be admissible to the twin.
- iv) Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, she/he will not get a scholarship for that class for a second (or a subsequent) year.
- v) A scholarship holder under this scheme will not be availed of any other scholarship/stipend. No scholarship will be paid to the students under this scheme from the date he/she accepts any other scholarship/stipend.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITION: The candidate should be a regular, full-time student studying in classes IX or X in a Government school or in a school recognized by the Govt. or by a Central/State Board of Secondary Education.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT: Pre-matric scholarship includes the following for the complete duration of the course:

- i. Maintenance allowance.
- ii. Book grant
- iii. Disability Allowance

H) Other Scholarships/ Concessions:

1) Concession in fee for the Student from Economically Weaker

Section (EWS):

The Government of Maharashtra has issued GR No. Misc-2022/ pk.91/vishi-4, dt. 22.06.2023, providing 50% (fifty percent) concession/scholarship in total fees to 10% (ten percent) students as per merit, belonging to the Economically Weaker Section, as per Govt norms, without considering cast or category, admitted in self-financed universities. This concession is to be given for completing the program. Students admitted in 2023-24 onward will be entitled to the Concession/Scholarship. After admission is completed, in the case of School where admission is given based on JEE and MH-CET, program-wise two separate merit Lists of the admitted students be prepared based on the students who appeared for JEE and MH-CET. In the case of schools, where admissions are given based on different CETs, different merit Lists as per their CETs be prepared. For any programs where admissions are given without CET, a merit list be prepared on marks obtained at 12th standard.

While calculating the 10% eligible students for concession/scholarship, 50% be taken from the JEE list and 50% from the MH-CET list, where admissions are given based on JEE and MH-CET and in case of other school

Lists as per their CETs. Then, documents be called from the students, who have not submitted by them at the time of admission, giving four days to submit the documents to prove their entitlement for EWS. A committee is constituted in the school under the chairmanship of the Dean/Director for the security of documents. Based on the report of the committee, lists of students eligible for EWS Concession/ Scholarship (50% from the JEE List and 50% from the MHT-CET List) be prepared and submitted to the Registrar's office.

While working out the 10% or 50% mentioned above, in the case of decimal, 0.51 be rounded off to the next integer, and up to 0.50 be rounded off to the previous.

The students from Maharashtra, whose total family income is less than Rs. 8,00,000/- (Rs. Eight Lakhs), per year are eligible to get the EWS Concession / Scholarship.

Proof of income to be verified from-

- If anyone in the family is in service, Form No. 16 is to be verified.
- If there is a business of the family, the income tax, GST paid, etc to be verified.
- If the family owns the land, then 7/12 extracts and 8-A extracts are to be verified.
- If anybody in the family is retired, then a certificate issued by the bank or bank statement, and income tax returns to be verified.
- Income from any other source (investments, dividends, etc.) be verified.
- Income certificate issued by the Tahsildar if a candidate belongs to a reserved category.

EWS Certificate issued by Tahsildar/Competent Authority if candidate belongs to open category.
