University Gold Medals and Rank
Certificate to Students Rules 2019
(Revised in 2021)*

REVISED CIRCULAR

Read: 1. Circular No. MITADTU/2018-19/350 dated 23.12.2019

2. Circular (Revised) : MITADTU/2019-20/392 dated 11.01.2020

1. These rules may be called as “MIT Art, Design and Technology University Gold Medals and Rank Certificate to Students Rules 2019”
2. These rules will apply to the entire Medal and Rank contenders from 2nd Convocation onwards i.e. form the Academic Year 2019-20.

3. Definitions

- A. ‘Programme’ means the entire course of study and examinations.
 - B. ‘Course’ means a segment of subject matter to be covered in a semester.
 - C. ‘Gold Medal’ is the ‘University Gold Medal’ and is not a sponsored Gold Medal. ‘Gold Medals’ are medals awarded to candidates who have successfully completed the respective programmes of study and secured the first rank in the concerned examinations.
4. The University shall award Gold Medals and issue Rank Certificates in all undergraduate / postgraduate programmes as follows:

- a) The gold medals will be awarded only to such students who fulfil conditions given in the Table below:

- b) University Gold Medals shall be awarded to students who successfully completed all the courses in the minimum prescribed duration of an undergraduate / postgraduate programme and secure the first rank in the examination.

- c) The students who failed, FR and involved in 'Unfair Means' case in any of the course during the entire program shall not be eligible for the award of Gold Medal and Rank Certificates.
- d) Students getting grace to pass the examination, get the promotion to next year or to get higher grade will not be considered eligible for Gold Medal or Rank Certificate. However, if any student gets a grace for higher grade, will be eligible to be considered for the same, if after deducting grace marks, he stood first or in rank.
- e) The award of the Gold Medal and Rank Certificates shall be subject to 'good conduct' of the student during the period of the program; this will be certified by the concerned HoI / Dean.

5. General Guidelines

- a) Rank Certificate will be issued to first three toppers, including Gold Medal holder, if any. For Rank Certificates, above clause of minimum student in batch appearing for examination should be at least five (5)
- b) In case of more than one student become eligible for the award of Gold Medal or Rank Certificate the Medal / Rank shall be awarded to such student who -
 - i. has obtained more marks / percentage, if CGPA is same
 - ii. has secured 60% marks in more number of courses
 - iii. has published research paper in refereed journals, applicable for PG programme (this is to be certified by HoI)
 - iv. has obtained more marks in eligible / qualifying examination (i.e. student of graduate program have same CGPA, marks then marks obtained at 12th will be considered, like wise for PG and Direct Second Year students).
- c) Even after the above screening, if more than one student becomes eligible for the award of Gold Medal, the medal shall be awarded to all the eligible candidates.
- d) Award of Gold Medal shall consist of 'Gold Medal' and 'Rank Certificate'.
- e) In the Rank Certificate, Program Topper instead of CGPA / Percentage, Rank 1, 2 or 3 will be mentioned.
