<u>MIT SCHOOL OF EDUCATION & RESEARCH – Ph.D. ADMISSION</u> <u>NOTIFICATION – 2017-18</u>

1. Eligibility Criteria

Minimum eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. programme in MIT School of Education and Research:

1.1 Master's Degree in Education, with minimum of 55% of marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 – point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

OR

Master's Degree in any Discipline/equivalent, with minimum of 55% of marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 – point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

OR

The candidates appearing for final year or final semester of their Post-Graduate Degree in Education will also be eligible to appear for the admission process subject to the fulfilment of minimum eligibility criteria in the final result thereof.

OR

Candidate's who have cleared the M.Phil. course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 – point scale and successfully completed the M.Phil. Degree shall be eligible to take admission for Ph.D. program

OR

A candidate whose M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated but viva voce is pending can be admitted to the Ph.D. programme.

- A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differentlyabled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
- All of the candidates should clear the personal interview as a part of Ph.D. admission test.

2. <u>Duration of the Programme</u>

Ph.D. programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years.

3. Modes of Ph.D. Programme

- A candidate shall take admission to Ph.D. programme in MIT School of Education and Research either in **Full Time** OR in **Part Time** mode.
- Full Time Candidates: Full time candidates will have to work from the MAEER's MIT School of Education and Research. Any fellowship holder will be treated as full time research scholar. The candidate/s must have a valid Score in NET / SLET in Education.
- Part Time Candidates: This can include "Internal" Registrant (Faculty/ Staff of University) and Registrants from other Institute/Industry/ Organization. They should visit to the MAEER's MIT School of Education and Research as per the requirement of the Ph.D. Programme. Part-time candidate should submit a No Objection Certificate (NOC) in a prescribed format (Appendix 1) at the time of Ph.D. application/ admission.

5. Selection Procedure

Selection to the Ph.D. programs would be based on performance in a written test, previous academic record and an interview. Only such applicants, who obtain the minimum required marks in aptitude test, subject specific test and the indicated total percentage of marks, will be considered for final preparation of result as given below:

- General/SC/ST/OBC: [Research Aptitude and Subject specific Test (FM: 30 + 70 = 100) = Weightage: 40%; Academic record & Interview (FM: 30 + 70 = 100) = Weightage: 60%; and Total Weightage: = 100%].
- A relaxation of 5% in qualifying marks of the entrance test will be applicable for SC/ST/ OBC students.

Duration of the entrance test will be of 2 hours: 1 hour for research aptitude and 1 hour for subject specific.

Question papers for research aptitude and subject specific will be set and evaluated by a board constituting of Head of Departments and the research supervisors for each department under MIT ADT University.

The candidates who have qualified the Entrance test would be required to appear before an interview panel, of the Department/ Institute concerned, as approved by the Vice Chancellor with Head of the Department being the Chairperson. The Interview board would consist of (i) Head of the Department, (ii) Two Professors (iii) two external subject experts nominated by the Vice Chancellor.

The interview process shall consist of assessing the candidates on the basis of the following three criteria:

- A research proposal (in 400-600 words) submitted to the interview board in the area of
 interest of the applicant. Board will consider the area on the basis of main two points:
 whether the study is feasible at the university and if the proposed study is contributing
 to new / additional knowledge.
- Presentation of the said research proposal by the applicant in front of the interview board.
- A personal interview

6. Syllabus for entrance examination

Candidates will be asked to answer questions related to research aptitudes and teaching aptitudes. Syllabus of research aptitudes includes: Types of design research, Basics of Research Methodology, Statistics, Logical Approaches to Research: Top down and Bottom up, Research Proposal and Research/Study Design etc. Syllabus for subject specific test will

include Philosophy, Sociology & Psychology of Education etc. Question papers would be composed of both the MCQ and Descriptive types of Questions.

7. Fellowships/ Assistantship Details

- Institute fellowships are available for full-time scholars.
- The candidates registered as full time research scholars will be eligible to apply for Scholarship from MITADTU depending on the merit list may be eligible for Rs. 20,000/- per month.
- Fulltime students have to work as 'Teaching Assistant' under faculty guide. Candidate might be responsible for conducting classes/ workshops/ tutorial development/ other research activates under guidance of Ph.D. supervisor.

8. Seats and Reservations

Total Intake for Ph.D. in MIT School of Education and Research: **08** (Jan'17 Semester)

All the reservation of seats will be maintained as per the current government norms.

- Candidate should submit dully filled the Hard/ Soft copy of Application form in prescribed format along with a tentative research proposal (500 - 600 words) stating his/her research of interest.
- Tentative application fee : INR 1,500
